WHAT IS DIRECTV NFL SUNDAY TICKET?

DIRECTV NFL Sunday Ticket is a premium sports subscription that provides access to every out-of-market NFL game broadcast on CBS and Fox each Sunday afternoon (excluding Thursday, Sunday, Monday, and primetime games, which are typically available nationally). For fans who live outside their team’s region, this package is the only way to watch every snap of their favorite squad’s season live.

The service is available in multiple tiers: the basic “NFL Sunday Ticket” and the upgraded “NFL Sunday Ticket Max,” which adds NFL RedZone, the popular whip-around show hosted by Scott Hanson, as well as access to streaming on mobile devices and tablets via the NFL Sunday Ticket app.

UNDERSTANDING THE DIRECTV NFL TICKET CHANNEL GUIDE: BASIC NUMBERS

DIRECTV organizes its NFL Sunday Ticket channels in a dedicated block, usually starting around channel 700 and extending well into the 700s and 800s. The exact channel numbers may vary slightly depending on your specific DIRECTV receiver model and geographic location, but the general layout remains consistent.

Main NFL Sunday Ticket Channel Block (Directv Nfl Ticket Channel Guide)

The core of the DIRECTV NFL Ticket channel guide is the multi-channel lineup for all out-of-market games. Here is a typical breakdown:

- **Channels 701-710** – These are the primary Sunday Ticket slots for the early afternoon games (typically 1 PM ET kickoffs). Each channel carries a different game from around the league.
- **Channels 711-720** – These channels serve the late afternoon games (4 PM ET and later). Again, each channel is dedicated to a single game.

On a busy Sunday, you might find up to 14 or 15 games in total, so DIRECTV uses additional channels in the 730s or 740s for overflow or for games that start in unusual windows (such as late afternoon or early evening).

NFL RedZone on DIRECTV

If you subscribe to NFL Sunday Ticket Max, you will also have access to **NFL RedZone** on DIRECTV channel 703 (or sometimes 704 depending on your market). This dedicated channel switches from game to game during every scoring opportunity, commercial-free action, and highlights. It is a must-have for fantasy football players who need to track multiple games simultaneously.

Local Channels vs. Sunday Ticket Channels

It is important to differentiate between your local CBS and Fox affiliates (which carry your regional games) and the Sunday Ticket channels. Local games are broadcast on your standard DIRECTV local channel lineups (e.g., channel 2, 4, 7, etc.). Sunday Ticket channels only carry games that are NOT being shown in your local market. For example, if you live in New York and want to watch the Buffalo Bills (who are your local AFC team), that game will air on your local CBS channel. But if you want to watch the Seattle Seahawks (out-of-market), you would tune to a Sunday Ticket channel.

HOW TO FIND THE EXACT DIRECTV NFL TICKET CHANNEL GUIDE FOR YOUR AREA

Because DIRECTV’s channel lineup can vary by receiver model (e.g., Genie, Genie 2, standard DVR), it is always wise to verify the exact numbers on your own system. Here are a few reliable methods:

1. **Use the DIRECTV remote guide:** Press the “Guide” button and scroll to the “NFL Sunday Ticket” category. The channels will automatically appear under a dedicated section labeled “Sports” or “NFL.”
2. **Visit DIRECTV’s official website:** Log into your account and look for the “Channel Lineup” page. Enter your ZIP code to see the full list, including Sunday Ticket channels.
3. **Check your local programming:** The DIRECTV on-screen channel banner often displays the team names when you scroll over a Sunday Ticket channel, making it easy to identify which game is on.
4. **Mobile app:** The DIRECTV app (formerly DIRECTV NOW) includes a channel guide that mirrors your satellite lineup.

WHICH DIRECTV PACKAGE DO YOU NEED FOR NFL SUNDAY TICKET?

Not all DIRECTV subscribers can order NFL Sunday Ticket. The package is available only to customers who have the **CHOICE** package or higher (including XTRA, ULTIMATE, and PREMIER). If you are on a lower-tier package (SELECT or ENTERTAINMENT), you will need to upgrade your base

programming to qualify.

NFL Sunday Ticket Max vs. Regular

The two main tiers are:

- **NFL Sunday Ticket (Regular)** – Includes all out-of-market Sunday afternoon games in HD (and SD where applicable). You get the main channels (701-720+), but no RedZone or mobile streaming.
- **NFL Sunday Ticket Max** – Includes everything in the regular package, plus **NFL RedZone** (channel 703), commercial-free fantasy tracking, and the ability to stream games on your smartphone, tablet, or computer (limited to two devices simultaneously). This is the most popular option for avid fans.

NAVIGATING THE SUNDAY TICKET CHANNELS: TIPS AND TRICKS

With so many live games airing simultaneously, it can be overwhelming to find exactly what you want. Here are expert tips for using the DIRECTV NFL Ticket channel guide effectively:

Use the “Mix” Channel Feature

DIRECTV’s Genie receivers offer a multi-screen “Mix” channel that shows up to six games at once. This feature is often found on channel 700 or 702 (depending on your receiver). You can select the audio for your primary game and watch the others in smaller windows. It’s perfect for fantasy football managers tracking multiple matchups.

Set Reminders and Recordings

If you cannot watch a game live, no problem. DIRECTV’s Genie DVR allows you to record any Sunday Ticket game. Simply navigate to the channel in the guide, press the “Record” button, and your DVR will capture the entire broadcast. You can also set series recordings for your favorite team to automatically capture every out-of-market game.

Sort by Team in the Guide

Use the search function on your remote to type in a team name. DIRECTV’s intelligent guide will display all channels carrying that team’s game, including local broadcasts and Sunday Ticket slots.

STREAMING ALTERNATIVES: DIRECTV STREAM AND NFL SUNDAY TICKET

In recent years, DIRECTV also launched a streaming-only service called **DIRECTV STREAM** (formerly AT&T TV). As of 2024, NFL Sunday Ticket is available to DIRECTV STREAM subscribers as well, offering the same out-of-market games via internet. The channel guide for streaming is slightly different — games are listed in a scrolling grid similar to the satellite experience, but the numbers are less prominent. Instead, you can find games by navigating to the “Sports” category or by selecting “NFL” from the main menu.

For those who prefer a pure streaming solution, the NFL Sunday Ticket app (available on mobile and connected TV devices) also mirrors the channel guide concept with a simple interface showing all live games.

COMMON QUESTIONS ABOUT THE DIRECTV NFL TICKET CHANNEL GUIDE

Why are some games missing from my guide?

If you cannot find a game in the Sunday Ticket channels, it is likely a nationally televised game (e.g., Sunday Night Football on NBC, Monday Night Football on ESPN, Thursday Night on Amazon/FOX/NFL Network) or a game that is available in your local market. Check your local CBS or Fox affiliate first.

Can I get NFL Sunday Ticket without switching packages?

Existing DIRECTV customers can order the add-on for the season by visiting their account online or calling customer service. Pricing varies each season but typically is a one-time payment (or installments).

What about NFL Network and NFL RedZone?

NFL Network is included in most DIRECTV packages (usually channel 212). NFL RedZone is only available through NFL Sunday Ticket Max (channel 703) or as a standalone add-on in some limited circumstances.
